Overview

Responsibilities

The Instructor/Writer shall develop government owned training, provide classroom support, participate in operational tests, training material validation, and provide effective training IAW established programs of instruction (POI). Instructors will instruct students to organize, train, and equip their assigned organizations to conduct prompt and sustained land combat operations through operational concept of unified land operations.

Duties and responsibilities will include the following:

- Perform services at Fort Gordon and other locations determined by training requirements and events; and perform training, receive training, attend workshops, present at conferences, or assess training events.
- Collaborate with current government personnel to establish acceptable training practices and student evaluation criteria.
- Periodically review classroom training materials such as student handouts, lesson plans, slides, and practical exercises for accuracy and adequacy.
- Obtain and record information regarding modification requirements gleaned from attendance at local meetings and conferences.
- Purchase Credentialing Vouchers from approved Credential Agencies.
- Foster a mentality of aggressive self-development in Cyber School students (e.g. 17 Series MOS),
- Deliver approved instruction to students for each lesson via interactive synchronous and asynchronous learning activities.
- Assist training developers, curriculum managers, and mission customers to design and implement a total training package; this includes creating instructional and evaluation content as required.
- Monthly review, update and analyze training materials and recommend changes.
- Provide daily attendance reports, and academic reports IAW Cyber School policy.
- Assist the Cyber School Training and Education Directorate Team in updating developing all related training material and training products for Cyber School curriculum.
- Maintain established classroom security requirements and procedures as prescribed in TRADOC Pamphlet 350-70-4, FG policies and CCoE SOPs.
- Maintain and report student attendance, academic records, and statistics to the COR or Cyber School leadership IAW Fort Gordon Regulation 350-5 and CCoE SOPs.



- Provide students with evaluation forms; administer and enforce test control standards; conduct assessments and testing in subjects taught; grade exams; evaluate results; record exam results; conduct AARs; and administer student course critiques. Develop performance-based and/or criterion-referenced tests associated with the new curriculum.
- Monitor and control entry and exit point(s) for a designated Testing facility or location.
- Utilize services of existing third-party government or commercial organizations to update training and deliver or assist with delivery of training requirements.
- Maintain classroom conditions IAW Cyber School SOP.
- Teach Cyber Protection Team (CPT) Methodologies, CCTC and other cyber related material as it is developed.

Qualifications

Required certifications:

- **Current DoD Active TOP-SECRET clearance with SCI Eligibility**
- Graduated the Support Cadre Training Course (SCTC) and either the Army Basic Instructor Course (ABIC) or the Foundation Instructor Facilitator Course (FIFC).
- Current driver's license.
- Possess at least 5 years' experience in and knowledge of operating system and network security.
- Shall meet requirements of OS and Networking instructor qualifications.
- Possess at least 5 years' experience in writing x86 assembly.
- Possess at least 5 years' experience in writing C.
- Shall have a deep and thorough understanding of Regular Expressions and Context-Free Grammars.
- Shall be familiar with systems exploitation without the assistance of toolkits like Core Impact or MSF.
- Shall be comfortable with reverse engineering patches to discover the original vulnerabilities.
- Shall be able to reverse engineer compiled executables to break encryption, retool functionality, and discover vulnerabilities.
- Shall be able to perform exploit development on compiled executables to include defeating standard binary protections such as stack canaries.
- Shall have experience in instructing the aforementioned topics.
