- Facilitate student preparation for courses, accomplishment of course prerequisites, and accomplishment of all course execution and graduation requirements.

- MA or MS in any field required from a regionally accredited U.S. college/university or internationally recognized college/university
- 5 years’ practical experience of conducting SOF sensitive activities, with specific expertise in planning, managing, enabling, and reporting of SA at the operational level, capable of explaining how to work across joint, interagency, and international communities to conduct the SOF SA mission.
- 2 years’ instructor experience required.
